Laity Spirituality Challenges 1



- "Regular Bible reading dropped over the last decade from 45% to 37%.
- Volunteering at church declined from 27% to 20% over the same decade.
- Church attendance has slipped from 49% to 42% percent.
- 40% of Christians do not attend church or read the Bible in a typical week
- 70% of Christians are not involved in a small group that meets for spiritual purposes
- There are more than 10 million <u>Christians</u> who are un-churched"

The "millennial generation" (born after 1980) is "less religiously affiliated" than any previous generation.¹

One in four Americans aged 18-29 do not affiliate with any particular religious group.

Millennials are twice as unaffiliated as Baby Boomers (born between 1946 and 1964) were at the same age.



¹ This is a compiled statistical average from many different parishes of different sizes from many different Metropolises and areas. This sample is constantly being updated, but the percentages are not changing materially, except for slight decreases in Stewardship and slight increases in Non-Parishioner income. Other studies have suggested direct stewardship levels could be much lower.






GOA Chrismations Are Declining






GOA Weddings Are Declining




Funerals 1990 - 2014 Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America

The Bottom Line Re: Christ's Church Under Our Watch

- Church membership is declining
- Church sacraments are declining
- Church contributions are declining
- Church member spirituality is declining
- Church relevance is declining
- Church stewardship is declining
- Church <u>dis</u>engagement by youth is increasing
- Church member deaths are increasing
- Church dependence on Festivals/Fund Raisers is increasing





The Three Key Stewardship Principles

















People who are asked to give of their time before they are asked to donate money ultimately give more money to the charity (49% more)¹

"...The amount of time spent volunteering is positively correlated with the amount of money that is given by individuals." (Those who actively practiced a religion donated 92% more to charitable causes.)²

"...church involvement is the strongest single predictor of giving." ³



The Mob Was Wrong







"Personal solicitation has an effect on both the decision to make a gift and the average size of the gift..." "...individuals are more likely to donate when asked by those who are similar to them" ¹

- "...the method of direct contact may be as important as just contact...higher levels of contributions involve a personal contact by a previously known individual."²
- "...solicitations to contribute are more often successful when they are made by a person with a stronger relationship to the potential donor or volunteer because a refusal to contribute will endanger the relationship with the solicitor." ³

- 6. Youth Stewardship ~ "engagement or extinction"





"A process to help manage the 'busyness' of our Parish without turning our Parish into a business."




What is Strategic Planning



- A process for clarifying our values, mission and vision, and determining a strategy to allocate our resources to achieve our vision
- A Strategic Plan must answer 4 fundamental questions:
 - 1. Why do we exist? (Statement of Why)
 - 2. Where are we now? (SWOT)
 - 3. Where do we want to be? (Mission/Vision)
 - 4. How will we get there? (Strategic Goals)

Bill's Essential 4 P's of Church Strategic Planning





The Essential 4 P's of Church Strategic Planning



- <u>PEOPLE</u> The right people developing and implementing the plan, with input from everyone ("You have to get the 'right people' on the bus and the 'wrong people' off the bus." - Jim Collins - <u>Good To Great</u>)
- 2. <u>PROCESS</u> A comprehensive, inclusive and methodical process and schedule
- 3. <u>PRODUCT</u> A comprehensive strategic plan with a detailed implementation plan and timeline
- 4. <u>PERFORM</u> Implementation must be wellmanaged and methodical (strategic plans in non-profit organizations frequently fail in this 4th step)








Bill's 9-Step "wHoly Engaged" **Stewardship Process** and **New Parish Operational** Paradigm (P.O.P)

Bill's 6-Step Parish Strategic Planning Process





- <u>STEP ONE</u> Opening Retreat (develop SWOT, Statement of Why, Mission, Vision, Core Values, Strategic Areas of Focus)
- **STEP TWO** Task Force meetings and conference calls
- **STEP THREE Second Retreat to finalize SMART Goals and Action Plans**
- **STEP FOUR** Finalize writing and preparation of Strategic Plan
- **STEP FIVE** Present Strategic Plan at Parish roll-out celebration event and solicit engagement
- **STEP SIX** Implementation (and continual communication)



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
