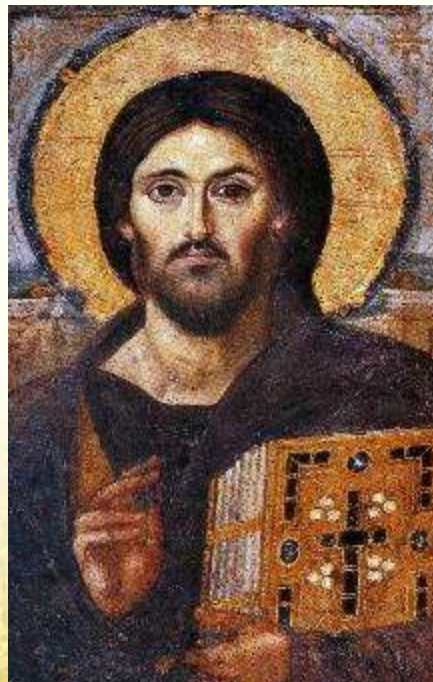

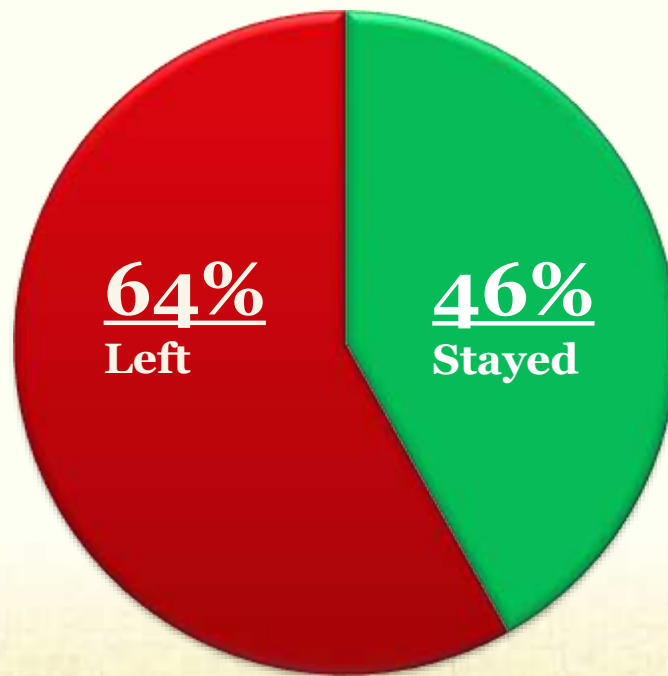

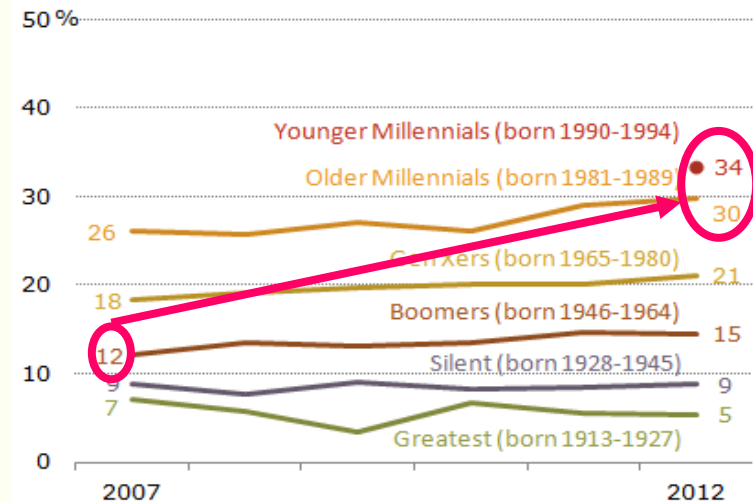
We Can “Kiss Our Youth Goodbye”

% of each age cohort that is unaffiliated



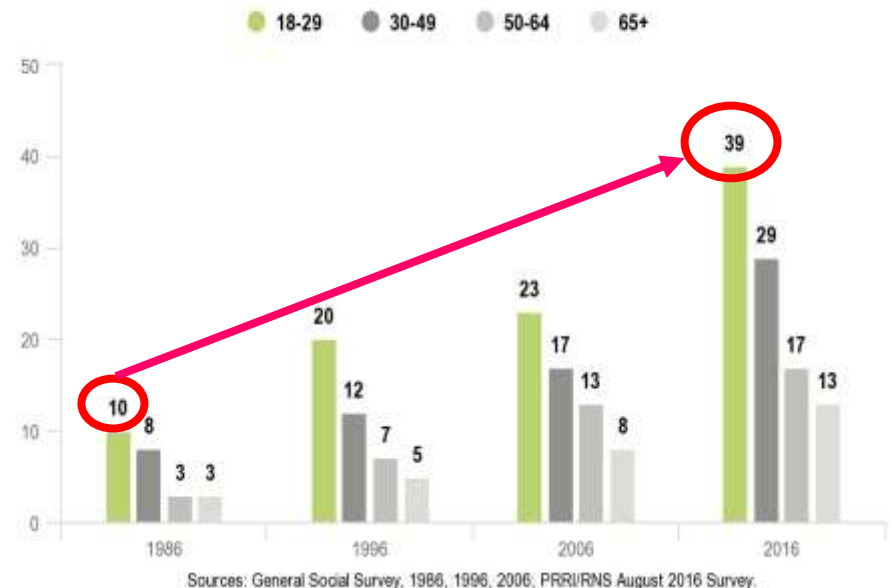

Youth Stewardship



- ~ What have you taught your children about the stewardship of God's gifts?
- ~ What have you modeled for your children regarding your personal stewardship?
- ~ Avoid the "Dollar Club" mentality (\$1.00 in the tray in 1955 = \$9.70 in 2020)
- ~ (10/10/80 Rule) First 10% of income is your tithe (of stewardship to The Kingdom); the next 10% is saved for the future/retirement and you live on the remaining 80%
- ~ Do you have any "millennial" or "Young Adult" positions on your Parish Council and other Ministry Leadership positions (a "big complaint from millennials about older folks")

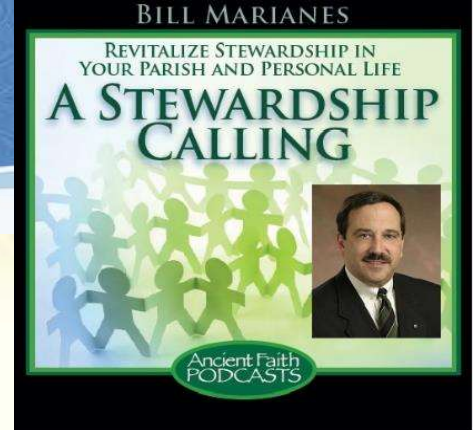

Youth Stewardship



- ~ If you do not have a youth stewardship program that teaches true stewardship, you have determined your Parish's unfortunate future
- ~ The Science of Generosity Studies remind us that it is critical to teach youth that stewardship over their gifts from God is a cradle to casket responsibility



You Must Have A Separate Parish Youth Stewardship



- ~ Different messages and solicitations change depending on their age**
- ~ Use understandable examples/messages**
- ~ Include ALL youth in annual Parish Stewardship Campaign (youth offer their own separate stewardship pledge)**
- ~ Youth stewardship pledge must also include a pledge of time and talents and also their treasures**



You Must Have A Separate Parish Youth Stewardship



- ~ Sponsor many different service opportunities (including mission trips)**
- ~ Use creative processes to help youth start to discern their gifts and callings**
- ~ Send monthly materials home for parents to reinforce the teaching and messaging in the Sunday School/Parish**
- ~ Recognize youth who practice stewardship in the Parish bulletins and other media and in church (have them offer testimonials in church - their examples will inspire others)**

Overcoming Donor Fatigue¹



1. **Develop and communicate key stewardship strategies**
2. **Focus on solutions to the problems they address instead of emphasizing the problems themselves**
3. **Frame their solutions in light of the proportion of victims being helped**
4. **Stress the similarities or interconnectedness between victims and donors**
5. **Identify a single victim who is being or has been helped by the organization**
6. **Implement strategies from fundraising best practices, thank and celebrate**

10. Thank and celebrate



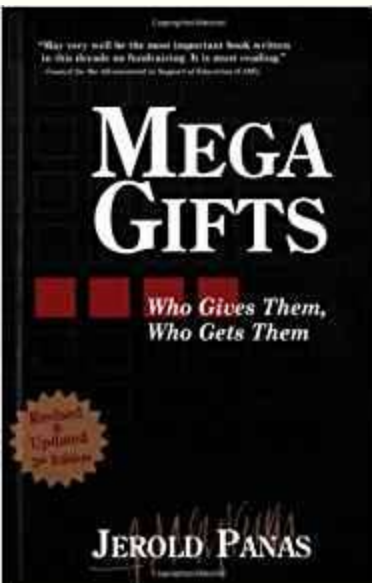

- 1. Cause / Mission (“Sell the**
- a) Explain the cause and mission**
- b) Relate the cause/mission to what is important to the donor**
- c) Give examples relevant to the donor of how your parish practices the cause/mission**
- d) Explain how their donation will help the parish better achieve its cause/mission**
- e) One size fits all communications fit no one**



C. P. I. Motivates Donors To Give



2. People / Solicitor / Leadership ("Sell the Team")



- a) People give to people who mean something to them**
- b) If you have a personal relationship with a donor, your meeting with them makes the solicitation special and personal**
- c) Connect the donor with other involved people/stewards of integrity**



C. P. I. Motivates Donors To Give



3. Integrity / Fiscal Responsibility ("Sell the Scheme")



- a) Donors do not give to causes that are irresponsible with funds or poorly led**
- b) Describe success of your capital campaigns and annual stewardship program**
- c) Explain the financial safeguards and financial integrity your parish has implemented**



Top Five Stewardship Communications Do \ Do Nots DO



1. Share your parish's vision and ministries
2. Share success stories from your ministries
3. Ask for their involvement / participation / time
4. Explain how their contributions materially improve lives
5. Be positive, encouraging and empowering

DO NOT

1. Focus on financial difficulties or problems
2. Use negative messages
3. Use the same message for every type of steward
4. Merely talk about money
5. Just use mail and email



Church Websites Matter¹



- 1. 97% of people search for local organizations online**
- 2. 96.2% of churches fail the “first impression test”**
 - Is there a primary focal point?
 - Is there a responsive design?
 - Is there a reasonably quick load time?
 - No stock photos of people’s faces
 - Easily accessible new visitor information
- 3. A Northumbria University study showed that the “feel” of a website is the main driver of first impressions (94% was about design and only 6% of feedback was about actual content)**

Church Websites Matter¹



1. 53% of internet browsing is on smart phones and tablets – so your website must work well on those devices
2. 80% of people will stop engaging with slow websites – (load in less than 3 seconds)
3. Stock photos of people are disingenuous and are a turn off - great photography attracts people's attention
4. 62% of church websites fail to provide easily accessible new visitor information
5. Users form an initial opinion of if they will stay or leave a website in ≈ 50 milliseconds (that's 0.05 seconds)²

Church Websites Matter¹



1. **64% of church goers say the church website is important in facilitating participation in church**
2. **What features do people say they use most (in order):**
 - **Listen and download sermons**
 - **Serving opportunities at the church**
 - **Finding service information**
 - **Forward content to others**
 - **Read visitor's information**
3. **Good church websites “EWE” educate, welcome and engage**

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Social Media Is Antisocial - So WWJD?



Social Media Is Neither Social Nor Good Media.

Many people are systematically allowing themselves and their children to become more depressed and addicted to Dopamine. This can add to a sense of loneliness, despair and helplessness. However, it is preventable.

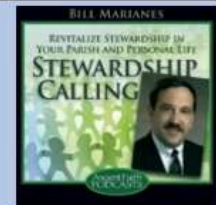
Pew Research Center found that over 85% of teenagers have and use social media each day, and over 95% have a smart phone that makes accessing social media easier. These rates are materially higher than a decade ago.

By one account, the National Survey of Drug Use & Health found that over the same (pre-Covid) decade, depression increased by 74% among teenage boys and it increased 100% in teenage girls. Yes, it doubled. And yet, social media can serve some very useful purposes in the lives of our churches and faithful.

Church social media guru, Fr. Barnabas Powell, and I will review the data on social media Dopamine addiction and discuss effective strategies you, your churches and families can use. We will also explore how to use social media positively as we focus on WWJD (What Would Jesus Do?) with the power of social media.

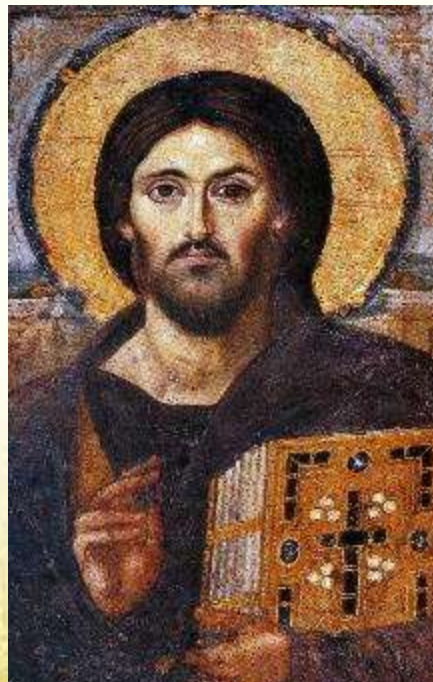
