





GOOD NEWS

- ~ 49% of all church giving is with a credit/debit card
- ~ 60% will give to their church digitally
- ~ % currently enrolled in <u>monthly church giving</u> = 40% of Millennials
 - 49% of Gen X donors
 - 49% of Baby Boomer donors
 - 30% of donors aged 75+

BAD NEWS

- ~ 37% of regular church goers give \$0
- ~ <u>17%</u> of American families reduced their gifts to their local church
- $\sim \frac{7\%}{100}$ of church goers reduced their giving by 20%+

The Big 5 Fundraisers

- 1. <u>Stewardship</u> annual contributions from your stewards through their direct stewardship
- 2. <u>Disguised Stewardship</u> (nickel and diming) from candles / trays / parishioner fundraisers, etc.
- 3. N.O. Income (Non-Orthodox Income) from festivals / rentals / fundraisers from non-parishioners
- 4. <u>Capital Campaigns</u> special contributions over several years for specific projects
- 5. Planned Giving including the church in an estate plan or making a special planned gift to a church endowment / special account

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Stewardship Campaigns



- 1. Annual, year-long stewardship campaign
- 2. Monthly stewardship articles in ALL Parish publications (Scripture + testimonials)
- 3. At least quarterly stewardship presentations
 - a. clergy AND lay testimonials
 - b. focused on life changing ministries (not problems) "people give to mission and vision"
 - c. emphasize time and talents ministry engagement
 - d. explain easy online giving options
 - e. emphasize tithing and % giving in each message
 - f. explain the incredible ministries that could be funded if everyone tithed



Stewardship Campaigns



4. Specific stewardship campaign month (sometime in Sept - Nov)

- ~ Plan personal contacts
 Plan A personal in-home visits
 Plan B group gatherings
- ~ Hand deliver stewardship packets for return to confidential place
- ~ Conduct a separate youth stewardship campaign
- ~ Focus on Ministry information and recruitment
- ~ Host a "Ministry Fair" and have ministries share their great accomplishments and recruit
- ~ Personal follow up to reach 100% participation
- ~ Celebrate successes
 - + ministry accomplishments
 - + lives changed
 - + specific metrics of giving



Stewardship Campaigns



~ Suggested homily/ testimonial topics:


- ~ "First and Last Giving"- Youth Stewardship and Planned Giving
- ~ "Give like God" = God gave first and Christ gave it all for us creating a spiritual culture of generosity
- ~ "Going All In" Tithing and Percentage Giving with incremental increases
- ~ Parable of Talents Give 3 parishioners \$
- ~ A Tithing Sunday (give/bring 10% of that weeks' income)
- ~ Zacchaeus Sunday give 50% of what you have in your wallet/purse/pocket in church that Sunday
- ~ A 90 day tithing guarantee (100% refund for anyone regretting their tithing contribution)
- ~Promoting culture of generosity (prayer circles or external focus)
- ~ "To every season" Campaigns around Seasons of Giving
- ~ "Seeing is believing" = Cast a Vision worthy of God and Christ's church

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Disguised Stewardship



- ~ The "nickel and diming" of our faithful by "selling candles or flowers" / passing trays / special fundraisers, etc.
- ~ These negatively impact our direct stewardship contributions
- ~ \$1 in 1955 = \$9.76 in 2021





Nickel & Diming and Non-Orthodox Income Dependence Proves Poor Stewardship Practices & Leadership



The average Orthodox parish¹ receives:

- a) $\approx 0.5\% 0.8\%$ (not 10%) of parishioners' income
- b) ≈ <u>52%</u> of its income from direct stewardship
- c) ≈ 20% of its income from nickel and diming its parishioners
- d) ≈ 28% of its income from Non-Orthodox guests (festival, hall rentals, etc.)

4-C Process To Stop Nickel and Diming?



- 1. <u>CULTURE</u> Parish leaders must decide the parish will become a percentage giving church (on the way to tithing)
- 2. <u>COMMITMENT</u> Parish leadership must:
 (a) becoming percentage givers/tithers; and
 (b) stop all nickel and diming by a certain date
 - (b) stop all nickel and diming by a certain date (e.g., 12 months later)
- 3. <u>COMMUNICATIONS</u> constant and creative education and communications from both clergy and laity

4. <u>CELEBRATION</u> – constantly celebrate life-changing ministries helping people and bringing them closer to Christ

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The N.O. Income Trap



- ≈ 28%+ of Parish income comes from N.O. Income (Non-Orthodox) sources e.g., festivals, rentals, outside fundraisers, etc.)
- 2. Festivals only started proliferating in the 1980's

3. The 2 Indicting Questions!



The N.O. Income Trap



- 4. Festivals are OK, as long as:
 - a) Parish doesn't depend on N.O. Income
 - b) the primary purposes are:
 - i. Outreach & Evangelism
 - ii. serving your community
 - iii. Parish team building and fellowship
 - iv. providing hospitality and sharing culture
 - c) You understand that Gen X, Y, Z will not work them like prior generations did

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Similarities Between Capital & Stewardship Campaign



Capital and Stewardship Campaign both must:

- 1. focus on the Parish Mission and Vision
- 2. have a dedicated team
- 3. reach every parishioner
- 4. include personal solicitations
- 5. have a schedule
- 6. use effective materials
- 7. include repeated, personal and public thanking
- 8. be conducted with integrity, accountability and transparency




Differences Between Capital & Stewardship Campaign



Capital Campaign	Stewardship Campaign
"all about the money"	about all 3 Ts
have a beginning and an end	permanent way of life (and re-occur annually)
begin with a "feasibility study" (interview of lead donors to estimate what can be responsibly raised over several years in calibrated bands of amounts of donations)	every parishioner should tithe / give a percentage of their income annually
begin with a "quiet phase" (soliciting the 20% of the people who generally contribute 80% of the money)	all stewards are solicited simultaneously
followed by "public phase" (solicitating the other 80% of people for the remaining 20% of the money)

12. Estate / Planned Giving

One of the greatest opportunities for financial security for a Parish is a specific estate/planned giving program



Planned Giving



- ~ 67 % of people don't know what "planned giving" means
- ~ Planned Giving is making a significant charitable gift during a donor's life or at death (part of their Will and Estate Plan)
- ~ The number 1 reason why donors include a charity/cause in their Wills is?????
 - "because they were asked"





~ Baby Boomers, (born 1944-1964), will transfer \$30 Trillion over the next several years.¹

~ As much as \$68 Trillion will be transferred within the next 25 years. 2

Who Is The Chuck Feeney In Your Parish?



- ~ Chuck Feeney co-founded airport Duty Free Shops amassed billions but lived frugally and wanted to die broke¹
- ~ Over 40 years, he anonymously donated \$8 Billion+ to charities
- ~ Who is the Chuck Feeney in your parish?





- ~ In 2017, <u>58% 60%</u> of people in the U.S. did NOT have an Estate Plan
- ~ By 2020, it had grown to 68%
- ~ Your State law will decide how to allocate your assets if you don't have a Will

~ Only 14% of the 32% of people with Estate Plans include a charitable bequest (4.5% of entire population)

~ Thus, 95.5% of parishioners is your planned giving campaign opportunity





- ~ The top 4 excuses/reasons people don't have Wills & Estate Plans:
 - 1. procrastination
 - 2. think they don't have enough assets
 - 3. think they are too expensive
 - 4. don't know how to do it
- ~ Your Parish's planned giving program can address all 4 reasons and do something wonderful for your parishioners and Parish



Why Have A Planned Giving Program? 1



- ~ Average Will charitable bequest = \$78,630 (20% of Wills have 2 bequests)
- ~ Multiply the number of parishioners by \$78,630 for an estimate of what your church can receive over time

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    100 = $7,833,000
    200 = $15,726,000

    300 = $23,589,000
    400 = $31,452,000
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~ Multiply the number of parishioners who died last year multiplied by \$78,630 as a conservative estimate of what your church could have received



Why Have A Planned Giving Program? 1



- ~ 95% of wealth is in stocks and property, so planned giving of these assets doesn't impact cash flow and can be done by people of all income levels
- ~ the typical planned gift is 200 times the size of a donor's largest annual fund gift
- ~ people who make gifts through their wills typically <u>increase</u> the amount of their annual support



6 Steps To Start A Planned Giving Program?



- 1. MINISTRY establish a Planned Giving Ministry Team
- 2. WHY determine the WHY of Planned Giving Ministry (what its proceeds will fund)
- 3. PROGRAM develop a comprehensive program of education, communications, resources and follow-up
- 4. ENDOWMENT create an endowment fund (consistent with the Archdiocese rules)
- 5. <u>COMMUNICATIONS</u> prepare and execute comprehensive and constant communications plans
- 6. <u>CAMPAIGN & FOLLOW-UP</u> execute the program with constant follow-up



Planned Giving Start-Up¹



How To Start Planned Giving:

- 1. Plan a fun gratitude event in "11 months" for anyone who included the church in their Wills
- 2. Regularly and often announce that event
- 3. Run your Planned Giving campaign, education and communications strategy
- 4. Announce final deadline for event
- 5. Have a fun gratitude event with a great meal, short uplifting message and great social interaction
- 6. Unveil recognition plaque
- 7. Repeat

Planned Giving



- ~ Naming your church as a life insurance policy beneficiary is an easy way to give (and possibly get a tax deduction)
- ~Planned Giving education and appeal should be a part of your annual stewardship campaign
- ~ Many estate planners/attorneys offer free education programs for parishioners



13. Transparency and accountability

Complete transparency and accountability is essential to having a successful Stewardship program





1. Transparency & Accountability increases generosity:

A significant increase in the public transparency, accountability, and institutionalized credibility of the many religious and charitable causes and organizations... would considerably increase the amount of money they received.





2. Parishioners want more Transparency & Accountability:

"Parishioners want more say in how their parishes are run.... In parish financial matters they expect accountability and transparency."





3. Transparency & Accountability is Biblical:

"In everything set them an example by doing what is good. In your teaching show integrity, seriousness and soundness of speech that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have nothing bad to say about us."

Titus 2:7-8

- ~ Transparency & Accountability have become absolute expectations



- ~ Only one trusted team member (and possibly the priest) have access to actual personal pledge information



Stewardship Team



~ Recruit Ambassadors = 10% of your number of steward "units"

- ~ Each Ambassador covers themselves and 9 other steward units
- ~ All parish council members, ministry leaders and Clergy are Ambassadors
- ~ Train all Ambassadors on how and what to solicit (emphasize vision, time, talents and engagement)


A key to a healthy Parish is to increase "Social Capital."



The Science Of Generosity Studies Identified 6 Basic Conclusions







Conclusion #1 (Cognitive Decision):

- 1. After thoughtful reflection, people form an existential opinion about themselves and their generosity at a fairly early age
- 2. It's shaped initially by their parents and the behavior of other adults important to them
- 3. If they don't decide to be generous when young, a parish can help people confront the key question: "What kind of person do I want to be?"

Conclusion #2 (Routinization of Giving):

- 1. After they form a personal generosity opinion, people look for easy and routine ways to be generous
- 2. Parishes must make sure to have easy electronic and other routine giving options
- 3. Parishes should have a standard donor giving timetable (campaign) and process (including your youth)





Does your Parish facilitate easy giving?





- 1. People model the behavior of their peers and those around them
- 2. A Parish should create and communicate a culture of generosity, and social networks that support generosity, for members to see themselves as a part of that generous culture
- 3. "There are no lone givers" peoples' giving is affected by who they know and how generous they are

Conclusion #3 (Culture of Generosity):

- 4. Encourage creative ways for your youth to decide to become generous
- 5. Get generous givers to talk constructively (not brag) about the joy their giving brings them
- 6. Encourage (do not shame) people to be generous in a variety of creative ways





Has your Parish created a culture of generosity and a social network to promote it, including your youth?



Conclusion #4 (Church Giving Facilitation):

- 1. Regular church goers generally give more money and are more generous
- 2. Generosity is improved when a church makes a religious call to give
- 3. You have to ask and remind not constantly, but consistently
- 4. Talking about needs or paying bills does NOT work at creating true and sustainable stewardship behavior "people give to mission and vision"





Has your Parish created regular processes to share its vision and life changing ministries and then solicit generosity?







Conclusion #5 (Parents Teaching):

- 1. Parents must proactively and explicitly teach their children about giving generously
- 2. Kids watch and mimic adults' visible behavior
- 3. Parent's generosity is usually invisible to their children, so you need to make it visible and talk about it to show them how you live, and how they should live

Conclusion #6 (Attitude of Abundance):

- 1. Parishes need to cultivate an attitude of abundance and gratitude, not scarcity, since most of us have plenty in our households
- 2. Attitudes of abundance have been shown psychologically and biologically to cause people to reframe their reality and allows people to become generous




The Tipping Point: How Little Things Can Make a Big Difference - Malcolm Gladwell

- ~ A tipping point is "the moment of critical mass..."
- ~ The turning point in an evolving situation that leads to a new and irreversible development
- ~ In epidemiology it is when an infectious disease reaches the point beyond any local ability to control it from spreading more widely
- ~ A tipping point occurs after approximately 16% adoption of any idea or product


