



Cradle Orthodox Adults Who Are Still in the Church







~ Barna Research says it has grown from a 59% drop out rate (2011) to 64% (2019)

hen Barna president David Kinnaman published his 2011 book You Lost Me, we heard from many people (especially church leaders) who were shocked to learn that 59 percent of young adults with a Christian background had dropped out of church at some point during their 20s—many for just a time, but some for good.

Eight years later, research for Kinnaman's new book Faith for Exiles: 5 Ways for a New Generation to Follow Jesus in Digital Babylon reveals that the church dropout problem is still a problem. In fact, the percentage of young-adult dropouts has increased from 59 to 64 percent. Nearly two-thirds of U.S. 18–29-year-olds who grew up in church tell Barna they have withdrawn from church involvement as an adult after having been active as a child or teen.







We Can "Kiss Our Youth Goodbye"



48% in Carpatho Russian parishes



Church Attentiveness Data




% OF TIME DISTRACTED

How is Holy Trinity GOC Doing

2019 Median Orthodox Tithe Analysis

- > Median U.S. Orthodox income = \$73,2001
- > 10% tithe = \$7,320
- > Your median = \$600
- > Your stewards are giving <u>0.8%</u> of Orthodox median income not 10%
- > If all 370 stewards made the median and tithed
 - > Stewardship income = \$2,708,400 instead of only \$409,921
 - > \$2,298,479 MORE!

- ~ "How do you explain why some people are able to achieve things that defy all of the assumptions ...or what other similar organizations can do."
- ~ "People don't buy what you do, they buy why you do it, and what you do simply proves what you believe."
- ~ "If you don't know why you do what you do, how will you inspire others to understand why you do what you do or to want to join you or your organization."
- ~ "The goal is not to attract people who need what you have. The goal is to attract people who believe what you believe."










- ~ This is supported by the tenants of biology
- ~ The (newest homosapien) Neocortex Region of the Brain = WHAT; responsible for rational and analytical thought and language
- ~ The Limbic Region of the Brain = WHY; responsible for all of our feelings like trust, all human behavior and decision making, and has no capacity for langauge

The enteric nervous system ("second brain") in our gut has 100+ million neurons (more than our nervous system)


- "The 2nd brain informs our state of mind..."








7 Jesus WHY Statements



- ~ "Then Jesus declared, I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty." (John 6:35)
- ~ When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."(John 8:12)
- ~ "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture." (John 10:9)
- ~ "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." (John 10:11)
- ~ "Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25-26)
- ~ "Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)
- ~ "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." (John 15:5)



7 Jesus WHY Statements



- ~ TO be the bread of life, SO THAT those who come to me will never be hungry or thirsty. (John 6:35)
- ~ TO be the light of the world, SO THAT my followers will have the light of life and not walk in darkness. (John 8:12)
- ~ TO be the door, SO THAT people can be saved (John 10:9)
- ~ TO be the good shepherd, SO THAT I may lay down my life for my sheep. (John 10:11)
- ~ TO be the resurrection and the life, SO THAT my believers will never die. (John 11:25-26)
- ~ TO be the way, the truth and the life, SO THAT everyone can come to the Father through me. (John 14:6)
- ~ TO be the vine, SO THAT a man can bear much fruit. (John 15:5)

Start With WHY?



- ~ Your WHY states your parish's contribution and impact
 - ~ The contribution is your primary objective
 - ~ The impact is the difference your parish will make
- ~ A WHY should inspire and explain your parish's purpose
- ~ It answers: "Why does my parish exist?" "Why should anyone want to join us?"
- ~ Your 1 sentence WHY should be:
 - simple and clear
 - actionable
 - focused on how you'll contribute to others, and
 - expressed in affirmative language that resonates with you and can inspire others
- ~ Building a consensus around you WHY is a key to a church's long lasting success and viability

"TO".....(the contribution)

"SO THAT".... (the impact)

Bill's Lawyer Statement of WHY?



~ Joey Asher's Even A Geek Can Speak helps people communicate more effectively. In his mastering the "elevator pitch" chapter, he included my 2001 "WHY"



Elevator Pitch to Prospects

Bill Marianes is a transactional attorney with the law firm Troutman Sanders in Atlanta. When people ask him what he does for a living, he says, "I'm a problem solver and dream facilitator." That's appropriate, because when people come to see a lawyer, he says, they either have a problem or something they want to accomplish. After hearing the Marianes elevator pitch, prospective clients are always lured into asking him more detail about what he does.

He never responds to the question, "What do you do?" with "I'm an attorney." That kind of response, he says, means, "I'm stuck with whatever box they put all the attorneys and lawyers in. I don't have a chance to distinguish myself."



- TO create engaged disciples of Christ SO THAT we may reflect the image and likeness of God in the world.
- TO guide all people to the love of Christ SO THAT we may live eternally in heaven with God.
- TO serve and nurture people SO THAT their path to salvation is an experience of love, peace and inclusion.



Other WHY Statement Examples



- ~ TO welcome those seeking holiness and salvation through a loving and nurturing spiritual family SO THAT we may manifest the presence of Christ on earth.
- ~ TO provide an authentic experience of transformational love, healing and peace SO THAT we may find the fullness of truth and salvation through Jesus Christ.
- ~ TO be a warm caring Christian environment SO THAT faith, service and community thrive.


