- 21 CHRIST-CENTERED spreading and teaching the Gospel; provide an environment that supports Christians and Christian families; Christ, understanding Him and being like Him; Christ-centered; becoming more like Christ; Kerygma (the Gospel message here and now); Jesus is alive and in our midst; Be icons of Christ; "Christ is Risen, my Joy!"; Provide a witness to the love of Christ; Hope in Christ's resurrection; Brothers and Sisters in Christ.
