


MISSION STATEMENT - HEAT MAPPED (Uganda Orthodox Church)

Option 1 – Full & Comprehensive (too wordy)

Option 2 – Balanced & Direct

Our mission is to proclaim the Gospel, live the Orthodox faith, nurture the faithful, and serve all people with love, compassion, and justice.

Option 3 – Concise & Memorable

To proclaim Christ, live Orthodoxy, nurture the faithful, and serve with love.

Option 4 – Very Concise / Tagline Style

Proclaiming Christ. Living Orthodoxy. Serving with Love.

Option 5 – Transformational Tone

To bring the healing light of Christ to all, by proclaiming the Orthodox faith, nurturing believers, and serving communities with compassion and dignity.
